We would like to cordially invite you to attend our Freshmen Orientation program for the Class of 2021. This is a program that has been offered by our student council for over 20 years, we have averaged 92% participation, and it has consistently received positive feedback throughout the years.

The goals of our Freshmen Orientation program are; (1) to reduce the stress and anxiety of students about attending a new school; (2) to provide useful information that improves student performance in the class- room and promotes active participation in our co-curricular programs; (3) to introduce our newest students to the culture and traditions of being a Saint; (4) to create a positive first experience for our freshmen.

Below is a listing of some of the activities students will participate in during the orientation. Students will be able to:

- Follow a mock school day. This will allow students to go through their actual schedules and find their class- rooms in a pressure-free environment, without our other 650 students present in the building. This helps alleviate some of the stress of not knowing what you're doing on the first day of high school and being over- whelmed by the crowded hallways.
- Visit each of their classes for 5-minute sessions. During each of the five-minute sessions, members of the student council will present information and advice that are relevant to starting off your freshmen year on the right foot.
- Locate their lockers & try their combinations to make sure their locker is working properly before getting their books on Saints Day which will be held on Monday, August 29, 2016 from 8:45-10:45 AM.
- Locate key locations such as the counseling office, the attendance secretary, the athletic director's office, the media center, and similar locations students visit on a regular basis.
- Receive information about upcoming events and opportunities at SCHS!

Registration for our Freshmen Orientation program will begin at 6:10 PM in the student commons/gymnasium area of the high school. Our program will begin in the SCHS gym. We ask that all students please check in no later than 6:30 PM so we may begin our program on time.

Our program is designed and geared towards the students' need and is not intended for parent participation. As students enter the high school, we believe it is important that students start to learn more independence and personal responsibility. In other words, there is no need or obligation for the student's parent(s) or guardian to attend the orientation. We certainly encourage and enjoy parent participation in many of our high school activities and events, but this one is best left for students to experience. Parents may join their students after the mock school day is completed at approximately 7:45 PM and are welcome to explore the building at this time with their students so all family members feel comfortable going into the first day of school.

Members of the SCHS Student Council will be available to help students locate rooms, lockers, and answers any questions students may have.
